The body of the young woman found at about midnight Saturday near the railroad tracks just east of South D Street has been identified as 20-year-old Nicole Michelle Rowe of 810 S. Third St.

According to the Jefferson County Attorney's Office, the Fairfield Police received two phone calls just before midnight Saturday of a possible female body wearing black clothing on the south side of the south railroad tracks near the railroad crossing at D Street.

Officers responded and found the body of a deceased young female just east of that location.

The body was transported to the State Medical Examiner's Office in Ankeny, where an autopsy was performed. The woman was identified by her fingerprints.

Foul play is not suspected at this time. County attorney Tim Dille said the death does appear accidental, and it is believed a train was involved.

The ongoing investigation is being conducted by the Fairfield Police Department, Jefferson County Medical Examiner investigator Mark Hagist, the Iowa State Medical Examiner's Office, the Division of Criminal Investigation, as well as the Burlington Northern/Sante Fe Railroad. The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office and the Jefferson County Attorney's Office assisted in the investigation.
